Please note our NABO dues are paid based off of paid membership count from the annual meeting and from Mus tournament in February. Liz moved to approve the treasure's report. Joyce 2nd the emotion and the motion carried.

Lukainka was sold at Living History Days (40#) and during JCF&R (80#).

Mick spoke to the membership regarding the dance performances the group attended throughout 2019. Practice is still being held at 5:30 pm at the Church Hall on Wednesday nights, all are welcome to attend whether to watch or to learn

and practice or learn and perform. Big thank you to Mick for his dedication to keeping the dances alive!

Trinity announced the results from the Mus tournament, held in February 2019. Batista and Johnny Juanicotena won our local contest. They then attended the National contest in Idaho. Over the years the BHBC has had several teams place in the top three at nationals, thus have had their names engraved on the national plaque. Trinity will get a picture of the plaque to share with BHBC. Thank you to those who taught attendees of BHBC Mus night!

New Business was discussed next. Trinity gave a rundown of the N.A.B.O. news from her trip to Mountain Home, ID as our delegate for the fall meeting.

- Ateak Ireki open the doors experience for young adults 16-25 to have an all-expense (except airfare and health insurance) paid 3 week trip to Basque Country to live with one of 15 Basque families who speak English. Must be a current BHBC to qualify. Need to sign up February 1st for summer of 2020. If interested speak to Trinity.
- Basque language program is available online, with teachers. Students in our local schools can use this program as their foreign language credit, because there is a way to evaluate and keep track of progress of students.
- Udaleku is being held June 21st-July 3rd 2020 in Salt Lake City, UT for 10-15 year olds. This is a good chance for our paid members' children to learn Basque culture. The BHBC pays tuition for those who want to attend.
- Jaialdi is being held July 28th-Augsut 2nd, 2020 in Boise, ID
- Trinity discussed the need for our club to have a designated delegate that is committed to attending the N.A.B.O. meetings, either in person or via the internet.

The BHBC then presented plaques to the Families of Madeline Harriet and Mary Lawrence to commemorate the time and energy they dedicated to continuing the Basque Heritage.

Whether or not to continue the monthly activities was discussed. Some expenses of the monthly activities were: postcards mailed out to the members announcing

the activities details, the library rent for couple of activities (\$10-15/use), food was purchased for Pintxo night, and Face Book and BHBC website were used to get the word out. These activities have helped to increase membership. They were a fun way to have members get involved, other than just during N.A.B.O. festival, and paid members get some value for their membership. We are the only club in the nation that offers something to its members every month.
